Serbia has one of the most liberal visa policies in Europe, thus enabling delegates from both EU and non-EU countries to attend the events without any visa procedure issues and additional costs.

#### CITIZENS OF THE FOLLOWING COUNTRIES DO NOT NEED TO OBTAIN VISAS:

- Citizens of the following may enter the Republic of Serbia using their passports and stay up to 90 days:
   European Union countries, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Iceland, Macedonia, Montenegro, Norway and
   Switzerland. Nationals of (provided they hold a valid passport): Albania, Andorra, Belarus, Israel, Russian
   Federation, Turkey and Ukraine.
- Rest of the World: Argentina, Australia, Bahrain, Bolivia, Brazil, Canada, Chile, Costa Rica, Cuba, Japan, Kazakhstan, Kuwait, Mexico, Mongolia, New Zealand, Oman, Republic of Korea, Qatar, Seychelles, Singapore, Tunisia, Ukraine, UAE, United States of America, Uruguay, Vatican Holy See, PR of China, Azerbaijan, Moldova.
- Nationals provided they are holding diplomatic and official passports, or ordinary passports indicating
  they are traveling on business: Algeria, Armenia, DPR Korea, Ecuador, Egypt, Georgia, Guinea, Iran, Laos,
  Lebanon, Morocco, Pakistan, Peru, Venezuela, Vietnam. Delegates holding a valid Schengen, UK and other EU
  Member States' visa, or a visa of the United States of America, can enter Serbia without any additional visa
  procedures.

The visa regime has recently been even more liberalized for 10 additional countries, a trend that Serbia will follow in the coming years.

Belgrade International Airport "Nikola Tesla" represents one of the main gateways to/from Southeast Europe. More than 850 flights are coming in and out of Belgrade every week with over 6.5 million passengers per year. In 2012, Belgrade airport was declared one of the Best Airports in the World by eDreams.

Through its signature of a 25-year concession contract, VINCI Airports has committed itself to transform the airport into the aviation hub for Southeast Europe and supporting its growth.

Should participants be arriving from far overseas destinations besides the USA, connecting flights are usually taken in Vienna (cca 6 times a day / 1h), Frankfurt /Munich (cca 4 times a day/2h), or Istanbul (cca 5 times a day/2:30h).



# SAVA CENTAR: YOUR NEXT EVENT VENUE

Sava Centar is **the largest congress, meeting and cultural venue** in Serbia, and one of the largest in Eastern Europe. The construction of the Sava Centar lasted for from 1976. to 1979. From the end of 2020, the venue is owned by private company Delta Holding which did the complete reconstruction process and it allowed reopening of a contemporary, fully modern convention center in November 2023.

As a true and very distinctive Belgrade 's landmark, the building of the Sava Centar was declared a "monument of cultural heritage" and is under the state protection.






# SAVA CENTAR: LAYOUT-GROUND FLOOR




# SAVA CENTAR: REGISTRATION AREA

The large registration area, as well as the foyers in front of the halls, can be suitable for organizing coffee breaks, cocktails and catering settings during the congresses and conferences.






#### **Main Congress Hall**

Diverse events can be organized in the hall, so it will be perfect for opening ceremony and largest panels.






#### **Immersive Hall**

#### Atrium - Green Oasis

Our Green Oasis is located in the very heart of Sava center, on the area of **up to 1.000 sqm.** It represents a networking area in which trade fairs, exhibitions, cocktails, coffee breaks and catering setups can be organized. Atrium-Green Oasis Also, **the green rooftop of 700 sqm** can be suitable for organizing the mentioned events.

The Atrium has a removable glass and there is a possibility of **connecting it with an Amphitheater that can hold up to 500 people.** 



#### The largest auditorium

Our famous "Blue Hall" is the largest auditorium in the region with a seating capacity of up to 4.000 people. Blue Hall will bring the most relevant and outstanding topics, performances, concerts, premieres, movie premiers, ballets, festivals , major world congresses.

#### **Exhibition Area**

Sava Centar has an exhibition space of over 8.000 sqm, with daylight, green areas and glass surfaces.

The largest exhibition space is in front of the Blue Hall with over 3.300 sqm, which will be suitable for organizing trade fairs, exhibitions, banquets, cocktails, parties, lunches and dinners. Additionally, this part of the venue has 1.200 sqm of registration area, and all together there is a wide range of possibilities for organizing different type of events.





#### **Green Facility Features**

Apart from preserving and modernizing, on of the main goals of the renovation project is to make Sava Centar **a more environmentally sustainable and energy-efficient facility**. To achieve that, several green facility features are planned, including:

#### Solar Panels



Sava Centar will install a large solar panel system on the roof of the building. This will generate renewable energy that will be used to power the facility and reduce its reliance on non-renewable sources of energy.

#### **Energy Efficiency**



Sava Centar will upgrade its heating, ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) systems to make them more energy-efficient. This will reduce the building 's energy consumption and carbon footprint.

#### **Green Roofs**



The renovation project includes the installation of green roofs on the building, which will help to reduce stormwater **runoff** and improve the building 's insulation.

#### **Energy Efficiency**



Installation of water-saving features, such as low-flow toilets and faucets will help to reduce the water consumption and conserve this valuable resource.




